- T / F** 2. For each individual event entry skated at all ISI competition events will receive one team point for participation in addition to the appropriate number of team points for their event placement.

- T / F** 4. It is acceptable for the skater to perform a “blade grabber” spiral as part of the arabesque requirement in Freestyle 2.
